*A message to Jefferson County residents (or wherever you reside). The general election is Tuesday, November 3. If you are not a registered voter you can still complete and submit a voter registration card. If you live in Jefferson County, MT call the Jefferson County Election Office at (406) 225-4020 and request a registration form to be mailed or stop by the Clerk Recorders office at 102 South Monroe in Boulder, Monday through Friday between 8 am and 5 pm. Ballots will be mailed October 9 to Active Electors only. If you are a registered voter and do not receive a ballot, contact the Jefferson County Election Office to update your information as necessary and receive a ballot. If you do not reside in Jefferson County, MT contact your local election office if you have any voting questions.

*There is still time to fill out your 2020 Census form. Spending just a few minutes to complete your Census form will help ensure Montana gets its fair share of federal funding. Filling out the form is quick, easy, safe and important. For more information visit CENSUS.MT.GOV/2020 CENSUS.GOV.
